

# High School Latin Teacher (Grades 9-10)

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## About the School

The Preparatory Academy of St. Joseph the Worker is a small private school launching in the Bedford–Irving area in Fall 2026. We offer an academically rigorous classical education (literature, history, mathematics, etc.), followed every afternoon by classes in hands-on skills (sewing, woodworking, cooking, etc.). In subsequent years, we will add grades 10-12, enabling development of well-rounded graduates, prepared for college studies, movement into trades, or pursuit of other paths, as desired by the student.

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## Position Overview

We are seeking a Latin teacher, to teach 9<sup>th</sup> (and next year also 10<sup>th</sup>) graders. Classes are 5x per week. We aim to provide at least 2 years of foreign language (required for Texas high school graduation), and have selected Latin as the language to be offered at our school, given its foundational place in the development of English and other languages, and how it trains the mind for logical thinking. Depending upon interest, we/you may offer additional years. You will have flexibility of selecting the text, keeping in mind the goal.

You must acknowledge that each student is a child of God, with unique capabilities and shortcomings. Your role is to allow them to recognize these as they progress, such that they deservedly grow in self-confidence through the year.

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## Primary Responsibilities

Teach Latin I to 9<sup>th</sup> graders (and next year Latin II to 10<sup>th</sup> graders)

Collaborate with school leadership on curriculum and program development

Assess student progress and provide timely feedback to students and families

Bachelor's degree in Arts and Science, including 3 years of college-level Latin

Desire to develop course content

Ability to teach across multiple skill levels

Commitment to the mission and values of a small private school

Texas teaching certification not required (private school)

Teaching experience preferred
